## 1. Notice

The notice of the AGM was taken as read.

## 2. Apologies

It was noted that the apologies that had been received would be recorded in the minutes.

## 3. Minutes of the AGM held on 14 July 2016 and Matters Arising

Following a proposal from the Chairman, which was seconded by Mark Weaver (Alsecco UK), the minutes of the AGM held on 14 July 2016 were unanimously approved by INCA members and signed by the Chairman.

There were no matters arising.

## 4. Financial Statements for the year ended 31 March 2017

INCA members were directed to the financial statements, including the income and expenditure account and balance sheet, for the year ended 31 March 2017.

The accounts showed a deficit of £26,337. This was due to a reduction in membership and a loss on the INCA Awards Dinner. It was the first time under the current Secretariat that the accounts had shown a loss and it would be funded with reserves which now stood at £109.497.

The Board was currently reviewing the budget for 2017/18, alongside the vision and strategy for the year, which would take into account how best to manage INCA given the challenges currently facing the industry, particularly since the Grenfell Tower fire. This could include a new structure with an Executive Chairman from industry supported by a Secretariat service from Build UK and this was broadly supported by members.

The Chairman proposed that the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2017 be received. This was seconded by Mark Weaver (Alsecco UK) and unanimously supported by INCA members.

## 5. Election of Board of Management for Ensuing Year

It was noted that, in accordance with the INCA Articles of Association, the Board of Management comprised the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and eight Directors made up of three Contractors, three System Designers and two Associates.

The Chairman confirmed that the following nominations had been received in advance of the meeting:

INCA would look to fill the two remaining Contractor vacancies to ensure the Board was at full strength at this critical time for the sector and anyone that was interested in getting involved should speak to the Secretariat.
